Honors Week Presenters' CHECKLIST

□ **Deadline 10/31/24**

Send an email to honors@wpunj.edu to confirm that you received the Honors Week 2025 checklist and application form.

□ **Deadline 12/1/24**

Submit the "Application to Present at Honors Week 2025" to honors@wpunj.edu. Your Honors Track Director may require additional documentation.

□ **Deadline 12/1/24**

Submit a photo of yourself to honors@wpunj.edu by **12/1/24**. Please write "Honors Week Photo" in the subject line.

□ **Deadline 3/1/25**

Submit a maximum 150 word abstract to honors@wpunj.edu by **3/1/25**. Please write "Presentation Abstract" in the subject line. Be sure to email a draft of your abstract to your Track Director for approval by 2/15/25.

□ **Deadline 4/1/25**

Submit a 10-second video of yourself that will be included in a video montage.

□ **Deadline 4/3/25**

Schedule an appointment with your Honors Track Director to rehearse your Honors presentation.

□ **Deadline 4/10/25**

Invite faculty members, family, and friends to attend your Honors presentation during Honors Research Week.

□ **Deadline 4/18/25**

Email your PowerPoint presentation to honors@wpunj.edu. Please write "Honors Week PowerPoint" in the subject line.

□ **Deadline 5/14/25**

This date is the deadline to submit your thesis project to the Honors College. Your Honors Track Director may request that you submit the completed project to them by an earlier date. Submit your thesis project with the "Thesis Cover Sheet" as the first page. (Projects will be submitted to the Honors College electronically and you will receive specific information about this process in April.)

Deadline 12/1/24

Submit the “Application to Present at Honors Week 2025” to honors@wpunj.edu. Your Honors Track Director may require additional documentation. Be sure to indicate “Honors Week Presentation Application Form” in the subject line. *Note about signatures: the form must be signed by your Track Director and your Thesis Supervisor (if different from your Track Director).*

Deadline 12/1/24

Photo/Publicity

The photo will be used for the Honors Week program. The photo will be quite small in the program, so a clear headshot works the best. If you do not have a suitable photo, please contact honors@wpunj.edu to make arrangements to stop by the office to have your photo taken. We must have a photo of each presenter and you must submit it to honors@wpunj.edu no later than 12/1/24. Please specify “Honors Week Photo” in the subject line.

Deadline 3/1/25

Abstract

Please submit a maximum 150 word abstract for the printed program. Examples of abstracts from previous years can be found [here](#). Be sure to look at examples of abstracts that were written by graduates of your specific Honors track. Please draft your abstract and email it to your Track Director for approval by **2/15/25**. Once you get approval, email your abstract to honors@wpunj.edu and specify “Presentation Abstract” in the subject line.

Deadline 4/1/25**Video**

Submit a 10 second video of yourself in which you tell us what was best about your track, or writing your thesis, or your Honors experience overall, or show yourself doing research for your thesis. This is optional and you will be provided with more information and instructions regarding the video in February. The videos are included in a montage that will be presented during spring celebratory event.

Deadline 4/3/25

Schedule an appointment with your Honors Track Director to go over your PowerPoint presentation and rehearse your Honors presentation.

Deadline 4/18/25**Copy of Presentation**

You must email a FINAL copy of your PowerPoint presentation to honors@wpunj.edu by **4/18/25**. Please send only one version of your presentation (the FINAL version). All presentations will be loaded on the computer that we will be using during the Honors Research Week presentations (note that the computer is a Dell, not a Mac). As a backup, you should also save your presentation on a flash drive and email it to yourself. Due to time and equipment constraints, you cannot use your personal laptop. Specify "Honors Week PowerPoint" in the subject line.

Deadline 5/14/25**Thesis Project Submission**

This date is the deadline to submit your thesis project to the Honors College. Your Honors Track Director may request that you submit the completed project to them by an earlier date. Submit your thesis project with the "Thesis Cover Sheet" as the first page. (Projects will be submitted to the Honors College electronically and you will receive specific information about this process in April.)
